Sheldon Coates Elementary School Continuous Improvement Plan

First 90- Day Cycle

The first topic our staff addressed is the implementation of a coherent, school-wide approach to intervention for students identified at risk in September.

SC teachers will use the Alberta Education reading resources, Heggerty Phonics, decodable readers and Literacy Place, and the grade level intervention materials in mathematics for numeracy.

Students will receive an intervention plan that reflects the area of support they need. Parents will be invited as partners-in-education to support the intervention work at home.
